"Let's read a little Scripture here." Luke 2:9-14, "Verse 9 reveals the angel of the Lord lit up the area all around the shepherds and said, fear not, but they were to receive great joy!" "Verse 11, the one who was being born was Christ the Lord! So today we do not receive fear, but joy in Christ the living Lord!" – "The sign was, the way that He was dressed and the location that He was at! The greatest and wisest of all was in the most humble place of all!" Verse 13, "With the angel was a multitude of the heavenly host! And they were praising God and so shall the elect! He came to get the predestined! (Eph. 1:4-5) – And He will receive everyone of them!"

"We witness every part of the Scriptures were given for a divine purpose and are full of wisdom and knowledge and symbols of truth!" Let us start with St. Matt. 2:1, "Now when Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judaea in the days of Herod the king, behold, there came wise men from the east to Jerusalem!" "Verse 6 reveals a royal governor would come forth!" Then in verses 9-10 it says, "When they had heard the king, they departed; and lo, 'the star', which they saw in the east, went before them, till it came and stood over where the young child was! When they saw the star, they rejoiced with exceeding great joy." "The significance of the star reveals the Holy Spirit was guiding them to a spiritual king!" "They were led to the spot of salvation; today 'the sign of the star' is leading us to His final acts of deliverance!"

Now the important part of the message. Verse 11, "Now when they came into the house, they saw the young child with Mary his mother, and fell down and worshipped Him, (you can only worship deity) and when they had opened their treasures, they presented unto Him gifts; gold, and frankincense, and myrrh." "Now the gifts definitely represented who He was, and what He was to do. They brought pure gold; this identified Him as deity in the flesh! It was the sign of the evidence! Gold always represents deity (Rev. 1:13 – Dan. 10:5) except when it is misused as the anti-Christ will do at the end of time! (Dan. 11:38) – This is the reason the beast powers want to control it (wealth) at the end, they want to usurp the position of deity! – "The next gift was frankincense, this symbolizes service, it means in service for God!" – "And the next gift was myrrh, this represented the anointing of His death!" – So all three gifts represented Jesus as deity in service for death. "Deity in the flesh passed through the channels of death for a moment, so He could redeem a fallen race! Absolutely! Here we see God and man joined together for service to redeem!" "The human part died, the deity part gave life again! The myrrh represented His burial and resurrection!" So we see the men were truly wise men, for they brought gifts which identified Him and revealed His mission! Amen! The significance is an amazing mystery, but it is a divine truth! "He was God's divine gift to the world, fully anointed for service." (Isa. 9:6)

"I was reading these Scriptures and perhaps they will be a real blessing to you!" – "Great is our Lord and of great power: His understanding is infinite!" (Ps. 147:5) "He knows all of your needs and will lead you!" – "Trust in the Lord, lean not unto thine own understanding, in all thy ways acknowledge Him and He shall DIRECT thy paths!" (Prov. 3:5-6) – "And the Lord direct your hearts into the love of God and into the patient waiting for Christ." (II Thess. 3:5) – "He is giving you peace, patience and rest! Praise Him!" – "Be strong and of good courage . . . for the Lord thy God . . . doth go with thee; he will not fail thee, nor forsake thee!" (Deut. 31:6) Yea, wait on the Lord and He shall strengthen thine heart!" (Ps. 27:14) End quote.
