

## SONG OF SOLOMON

The Lord has appeared and forewarned me that the things above us and beneath us will cause cataclysmic shaking and a catastrophe of the first order! But the elect who are watching and praying will escape the apocalyptic times of the closing age!

The Lord has spoke to me to put this part of the Bible in the rest of this special writing. It shows His unchallenging love and mercy for His people. As we can see in II Sam. 22:44-45, David was patterning and typing the future about Christ when he would receive a new people that would obey Him (the Gentiles)! **“Thou also hast delivered me from the strivings of my people, thou hast kept me to be head of the heathen: ‘a people which I knew not shall serve me!’ Strangers shall submit themselves unto me: as soon as they hear, they shall be obedient unto me!”** David tells of the infallible rock of mercy. **Verse 47, “The Lord liveth: and be blessed by my rock; and exalted be the God of the rock of my salvation!”** Also in II Sam. 23:1-2, reveals the last words of David, the anointed of God. As the lily among thorns, so is my love among the daughters. As the apple among the trees of the wood, so is my beloved among the sons. I sat down under His shadow with great delight, and his fruit was sweet to my taste! He brought me to the banqueting house, and his banner over me was love! Stay me with flagons, comfort me with apples: for I am sick of love. His left hand is under my head, and his right hand doth embrace me. I charge you, O ye daughters of Jerusalem, by the roses, and by the hinds of the field, that ye stir not up, nor awake my love, till he please! The Voice of my beloved! behold, he cometh leaping upon the mountains, skipping upon the hills! My beloved is like a roe or a young hart: behold, he standeth behind our walls, he looketh forth at the windows, shewing himself through the lattice! My beloved spake, and said unto me, Rise up, my love, my fair one, and come away! For, lo, the winter is past, the rain is over and gone; the flowers appear on the earth; the time of the singing of birds is come, and the voice of the turtle is heard in our land! The fig tree putteth forth her green figs, and the vines with the tender grape give a good smell. Arise, my love, my fair one, and come away! O my dove, that art in the clefts of the rock, in the secret places of the stairs, let me see thy countenance, let me hear thy voice; for sweet is thy voice, and thy countenance is comely! Take us the foxes, the little foxes, that spoil the vine: for our vines have tender grapes! My beloved is mine, and I am his: he feedeth among the lilies unto the day break, and the shadows fled away, turn, my beloved, and be thou like a roe or a young hart upon the mountains of Bether!” Amen!**

“Does He care for you? Jesus certainly does and it doesn’t make any difference how old or young you are! In this song He portrays and displays His incomparable divine love for you, His elect male and female, the church royal!” The hour of His uniting of the bride is here, the end is getting close. The Holy Spirit led me to put Solomon’s Song in this letter to the saints, the whole elect company, the first fruits unto the Lamb! – In Solomon 6:10 he further describes the Lord’s Church, “Who is she that looketh forth as the morning, fair as the moon, clear as the sun, and terrible as an army with banners?” Read in Solomon 5:10-16, “he describes Christ’s beauty!”
